Here at Bodmin Police Station we hope everyone had a great Christmas!

Our Emergency Services work 24 hours a day and we had officers dealing with a number of jobs over Christmas Day and Boxing Day.

Here is a small snapshot of what units attended.

Our Response colleagues started Christmas Day straight out the door to assist Ambulance at a Care home. We had a 60-year-old female suffering a medically induced psychosis. She was climbing into other resident's rooms and shouting. Units assisted with getting her into an ambulance.

Units then went straight to a Domestic Assault resulting in the arrest of a very violent male requiring leg restraints.

We also had a couple lost in the dark on Rough Tor resulting in Cornwall Search and Research being called out.

Boxing day started just after midnight with units attending an unconscious female in the road. We also had a Road Traffic accident after a car crashed into a sheep.

Finally, units attended a male trying to self-harm with a knife in his home address. Units managed to escort the male to hospital where they remain with him for the next 12 hours.

In total there was 34 incidents reported to Bodmin and Wadebridge Police over Christmas and Boxing Day.
